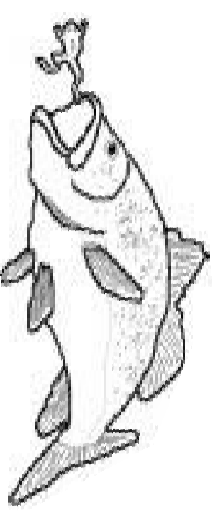

Bass Tournament Rules

1. All State, Coast Guard, Federal and Parks and Wildlife Regulations shall apply at all times.
2. Only largemouth AND smallmouth will be weighed in.
3. Launch will be by order of entry form & fee's received.
4. A contestant is not permitted to fish nearer than 50 yards from another tournament boat, which is anchored, tied or fishing the shoreline unless permission is granted.
5. The three (3) largest bass you enter will be your total.
6. Entry fee MUST be paid BEFORE fishing.
7. Fish must be alive when weighed in.
8. You may weigh-in fish or be checked in BY 3:30. NO EXCEPTIONS.
9. The tournament will be held regardless of weather conditions.
10. Fishing will be done with one rod and reel per person and artificial lures only (pork rind acceptable). No trolling.
11. Substitution is allowed if you are unable fish on the days paid for. Written permission is required and a new entry form will be filled out.
12. Taxes, title, registration, license, and other fees are the responsibility of the contestants.

**NOTE: These rules will be finalized and can be changed before the tournament. Your final rules will be distributed at the tournament.**

A dinner will be served at the boat launch/park area. Prizes and a raffle/giveaway will be given out at that time.
